Call for papers

When you submit your proposal, please pick one session from those suggested by the organizing committee and individual researchers. The full list of sessions and their descriptions can be found on the 15th ICNS website: <https://nubianstudies2022.uw.edu.pl/main-sessions/>.

The time limit set for session papers is 20 minutes. The proposal should include an abstract containing between 150 and 300 words. In case of presentations delivered by more than one author, each contributor should fill a separate form.

In order for a thematic session to take place, it must include at least four papers. Sessions with fewer papers will be cancelled and the organizing committee will propose to move the papers to other, thematically related sessions.

The deadline for submitting paper proposals is **31 March 2022**.
